What is a myocardial perfusion scan?

A myocardial perfusion scan is used to evaluate coronary artery disease, which is a narrowing of the blood vessels that supply oxygen to the heart muscle. As this disease progresses, the heart may not receive enough oxygen at times, especially when it's under stress. This may result in a chest pain called angina.

The scan uses radioactive substances (radionuclides) called thallium, sestamibi, technetium or cardiolyte that can be used to produce pictures of patient's heart. When the radionuclide is injected into the bloodstream, it travels to the heart muscle through the coronary arteries. This process can be visualized by a special camera. The results of your myocardial perfusion scan will help your doctor determine whether coronary artery disease is limiting flow to your heart. This scan will help him choose the right treatment for you.

EXAMPLES OF PRODUCTS THAT CONTAIN CAFFEINE

BEVERAGES: **cocoa**, **coffee** (brewed, instant or decaffeinated), regular and caffeine-free **soda** (coca-cola, diet cola, tab, pepsi, diet pepsi, dr. pepper, mr. pibb, mello yellow, mountain dew) **tea** (brewed, iced or instant)

FOODS: chocolate (chocolate candy, baking chocolates, cake, pudding, chocolate milk, and brownies

DRUGS: anacin, cafergot, esgic, Excedrin, fioricet, fiorinal, nodoz, norgesic, norgesic forte, synalgos, wigraine, vivarin
